



2018 Native Prairie Restoration/Reclamation Workshop:
Look to the Future, Learn from the Past
Poster Session Guidelines

Presentation Area

Each presentation will be allocated an area measuring 48"(height) x 48"(width) and participants are encouraged to maximize this space. If posters have been produced for previous workshops and are smaller in size, they will be accepted.

General Appearance

Poster presentations can include pictures, graphs, tables, captions, headlines etc. Presentation materials should be mounted on light-colored poster board—cardboard or heavyweight paper that provides sufficient rigidity—using push-pins.

Use of color images can greatly enhance the visual quality of a poster and can help in economizing on words in the written portion of the message.

Lettering

To facilitate easy comprehension and reading of a poster, the following dimensions are suggested: (1) pictures, graphs, charts - at least 20.3 cm x 25.4 cm, (2) title and author's name - 28 mm, (3) text - 8 mm, (3) captions for illustrations - 6.4 mm, and (4) lettering on graphs/table - 4.7 mm.

Set-Up

Set-up times: Tuesday February 7th, 2017 from 3:00pm-5:00pm & 7:00pm-9:00pm, or Wednesday February 8th, 2017 between 7:00am-8:00am. Exact times are subject to change.

Each presenter will be assigned a portion of a 4'x8' poster board panel. Posters must be taken down by 4:00 pm on Thursday, February 9th, 2017. Pushpins will not be provided - poster presenters must bring their own supplies to affix their poster. Business cards, brochures and flyers are permitted.

Time and Place

The Poster Session will be held in the Mezzanine for the duration of the conference. Presenters should be available during workshop scheduled times through the two days to answer questions and talk about their work.

Abstract Submissions

To apply for a poster presentation, please submit a poster abstract, poster title, approximate poster dimensions, and poster authors by **December 8th, 2017** to caitlinmroz@hotmail.com. Poster abstracts should be no longer than 250 words. Due to limited space, posters will be accepted based on relevance to conference. Upon acceptance, poster presenters will be notified about their specific poster location.
