Contest: Take a picture of native prairie and send it to us! One winner will be chosen in each category.

Photos will be judged by the following criteria:

- Understanding of **Native Prairie** (ex: native plants, and endangered species found on the prairies)
- Use of prairie symbolism (ex: needle and thread grass, bison, prairie dog, sky, and more)
- Artistic ability
