

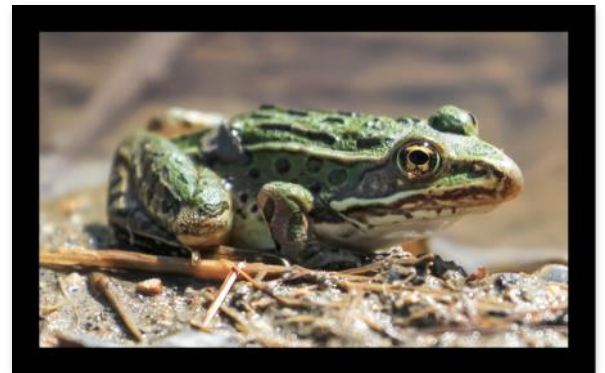

Conrad Jaeger, Grasslands National Park

## **Presentation summary:**

Conrad's talk will cover the native species of Grasslands National Park, the survey techniques used to assess their local populations, and the conservation status of those species.

## **About the Speaker:**

Conrad Jaeger is a Wildlife Biologist with Grasslands National Park, and he primarily works on at risk snake, lizard, and frog species. Conrad is from Cochrane, Alberta and he grew up hunting, fishing, and camping, where he became passionate about the outdoors and wildlife. He earned a Bachelor of Science in Biology from the University of Calgary, and a Master of Environmental Science from the University of Toronto. Since graduating, Conrad has worked as a biologist with consulting companies in northern Alberta and with Parks Canada in Banff National Park until taking a position in Grasslands National Park. Some of his favorite aspects of the job include going to remote places, seeing unique wildlife behaviour, and getting to learn from local community members.
