Virtual Poster Session: A Step By Step Guide

Step 1: Registration

Step 2: Access

In mid-January, you will receive access to your Pheedloop Profile.

Step 3: Optional Training

Watch the PheedLoop Training Video for Exhibitors. While the Poster Session will be in the "Showcase" and not the "Exhibit Hall," the set up will be the same. The ROI section or Live Video booths is not applicable to Poster Presenters in the Showcase.

Step 4: "Set-Up Your Poster"

Your "Poster" can follow one (or both) of the following options:

Option 1: Slide Deck

For presenters opting to upload a pdf of their poster, Poster Presenters are encouraged to follow these guidelines. For ease of viewing for workshop participants, we are asking poster presenters to present their poster on 5 slides:

1. Introduction
2. Project/Program Objectives
3. Methods
4. Analysis
5. Conclusion

Size Limit: 25mb per file

Keep in mind that each slide will be viewed on a computer screen in pdf format, so we recommend a font size of about 30pt for headings and 18pt for text, rather than the typical font size for a powerpoint presentation.

Option 2: Pre-recorded Video (recommended)

Upload a promotional video. Supports a single MP4 file up to 100 MB (duration of video depends on resolution, usually 5 - 10 minutes of HD quality), typically 16:9 aspect ratio. Visible on each poster's virtual event profile page. Videos are displayed on loop and start muted.

Our Recommendation for the Video:

- Create a power point presentation with 5 slides of your poster
- Through your presentation program (ex: Microsoft Powerpoint), record your presentation with audio and slide timings
- Export your presentation as an MP4 file
- Upload your MP4 file

Option 3: Both Slide Deck and Video

Follow the steps above to complete and upload a slide deck and video.

Please select the best poster set up for your needs.

Whichever option you choose, you will also need to set up your Profile. You may need logos, links and images.
