Cost: \$40/person (includes transportation between Regina and the pasture, naturalist guides that will answer your questions and a picnic supper on the prairie)

To bring: hat, long pants, dress in layers, bug repellent, sunscreen, reusable water bottle, sturdy walking shoes or hiking boots (at the very least, closed toed shoes), field guides, binoculars.

Please note that there will not be drinks included in your supper, please bring enough water for the duration of the trip. There will be a toilet on the bus.
